

BLACK LAKE ASSOC. MEETING

June 13, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., after, a very delicious pot luck with 25 members present. With special consideration given to our guest Andrea F. Sullivan, Senior Geologist with the DEQ out of the Gaylord Field Office the pledge and minutes from previous meeting were held off until after her presentation.

Andrea presented facts about the fracking of wells in the area and informed the membership that over 1200 wells have been fracked in Michigan since 1950.

DNRE does not support nor oppose the drilling, they monitor the process. Before drilling, the company must identify the chemicals and the DNRE must be aware of what is used in the area. Andrea showed a video. The DNRE reviews well logs in the area, wells must be drilled 100 ft below the lowest known well and set for 12 hours without touching after.

Virgil Smith presented Ms. Sullivan with a hat from the Association and thanked her for her presentation.
