June 8, 2015

The meeting began at 6:00 p.m. with our annual Potluck Dinner. Thirty members were present.

**Guest Speaker-** A presentation was given on aquatic vegetation by the Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council. Two surveys were given in 2005 and 2014. The results were compared to view what has happened over time. Black Lake has an average level of vegetation compared to neighboring lakes. 82% of the lake has little or no vegetation. The North western portion of the lake is very shallow so is more susceptible to plant growth. Zebra mussels and the river are providing nutrients for heavy plant growth. Eurasian Phragmites, an invasive wetland plant, was found in two locations along the north shore. Another invasive plant, Purple loosestrife, was found toward the north end of the west shoreline. The property owners will be notified and we will work with them eradicate these problems.
