### **Meeting by phone conference.**

We have been contacted by, and will be working with the US Geological Survey Upper Midwest Water Science Center who is working with Michigan Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy and Department of Health and Human Services looking at algal blooms in lakes around Mi. They will be collecting samples from Black Lake and analyzing them, Dave Turzewski has agreed to be the contact person for this project. More to follow.

Ron Dulak will contact Cam Cavitt, Cheboygan Drain commissioner and see if he can present at our July meeting. He will be discussing lake levels on Black Lake.
